Affiliated Tribes of Northwest Indians:

Facilitation of strategic planning with leadership and constituent surveys to define a shared vision, strategic pillars, actions, and priorities for the next 5 years.



Coquille Indian Tribe:

Facilitation of a community-wide visioning process for the 15-year *Ko-Kwel Nations 2039* Aspirations plan, incorporating landscape analysis, community surveys and meetings, and reporting.



Commonwealth of Massachusetts:

Co-development of the state's first Tribal and Indigenous Environmental Justice Strategy through statewide engagement sessions, shared visioning, and a communications plan to strengthen government-to-government partnerships.



Prairie Band Potawatomi Nation:

Facilitation of a community-driven strategic plan to strengthen language revitalization, align operations, and create a responsive, culturally grounded framework for the Language Department's next 5–7 years.



California Rural Indian Health Board:
